



# SAINT ANSELM COLLEGE SURVEY CENTER APRIL 2019 POLL ELECTED OFFICIALS FAVORABILITY/JOB PERFORMANCE

These results are from the Saint Anselm College Survey Center poll based on interviews with 698 randomly-selected registered voters in the state of New Hampshire. Interviews were conducted by landline and cellular phone between April 3<sup>rd</sup> and April 8<sup>th</sup>, 2019. The overall survey has a margin of sampling error of 3.7% with a confidence interval of 95%; the margin of sampling error for questions specific to the 1<sup>st</sup> and 2<sup>nd</sup> Congressional Districts is 5.3% and 5.1% respectively; the margin of sampling error for questions specific to the Democratic and Republican Presidential Primaries is 5.4% and 6.0% respectively. Data are weighted based on a voter demographic model derived from historical voting patterns, but are not weighted by party registration or party identification.

New Hampshire Institute of Politics Executive Director Neil Levesque summarized the results, saying, "With voters beginning to focus their attention on the upcoming presidential primary, the popularity of New Hampshire's elected officials has remained stable since our last poll in February. 61% of voters have a favorable impression of both Governor Chris Sununu and Senator Jeanne Shaheen, 55% view Senator Maggie Hassan favorably, and 52% and 50% have favorable impressions of Congressman Chris Pappas and Congresswoman Annie Kuster respectively.

Levesque continued, "As was the case in February, this popularity is driven by voters' approval of the job their elected officials are doing: 66% approve of Sununu's job performance, 57% approve of the job both Senators are doing, and 50% and 51% approve of Pappas and Kuster's job performance respectively. We can expect these numbers to change as voters get more polarized closer to the election, but for now, the governor and delegation will be building re-election campaigns on a solid foundation of voter support.

Levesque concluded. "President Trump has likewise remained remarkably stable despite an eventful couple months since February. His favorability and job approval have settled at 40% and 41% respectively, virtually unchanged since our last poll. He remains uniquely polarizing, with over three-quarters of voters reporting that they either strongly approve or disapprove of him. It's a safe bet that he will continue to dominate the political discussion through the presidential primary and beyond."
